GAG ACT TALKING POINTS



Elected legislators should be accountable to the people they represent, but these bills will allow them to shield the truth from their constituents, removing all accountability.

The onerous requirements needed to get a government stamp of "approval" would include a total loss of privacy for supporters of grassroots organizations.
