PUBLIC CAMPAIGN FINANCING TALKING POINTS

The right to free speech – including political speech – is a cornerstone principle of liberty. America’s founding fathers understood this and protected this right in the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution’s Bill of Rights.

Politicians want you to believe “Public Campaign Financing” will clean up the political process, but the legislation actually protects and enriches politicians under the guise of “reform” and is a direct violation of our constitutionally protected rights.

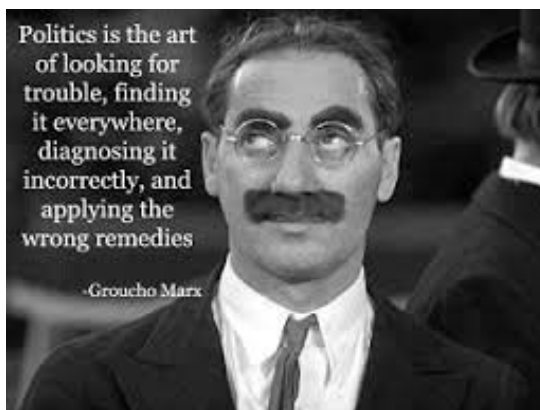
Public Campaign Financing:

- Forces you to fund candidates for office you don’t support.
- Rewards politicians for bad behavior.
- Is a smokescreen that limits your 1st Amendment rights.
- Allows politicians to secure their power in office by ensuring their constituents will fund future campaigns, regardless of their voting record.
- Forces you to participate in elections, whether you want to or not.

Public Financing silences opposition to a candidate and his views, by ensuring non-supporters will still be compelled to fund his efforts.

It is contrary to liberty to force Americans to participate in any activity – including campaigns for office.

Americans should be free to choose whom they will support with their money.
